#1	PINOT NOIR, COOPERS HALL, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OR '16 Here we offer a wine that is easy to like. It's easy to ask for a second glass with this one.	2OZ. \$4	GL \$11	46CL \$28
#2	CABERNET SAUVIGNON, COOPERS HALL, COLUMBIA VALLEY, WA '15 A ripe, rich wine with a little more oak than you generally see from us.	2OZ. \$4	GL \$10	46CL \$25
#3	CASCADE RED, COOPERS HALL, OR NV Our non-vintage red blend leans heavily on Cabernet Franc that we source from one of our vineyard partners in the Applegate Valley. The rest of the blend is currently Pinot Noir sourced from the Willamette Valley with a little Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec sourced from the Applegate.	2OZ. \$3	GL \$8	46CL \$20
#6	TEMPRANILLO, COOPERS HALL, STEELHEAD RUN VINEYARDS, APPELEGATE VALLEY, OR '15 A ripe, juicy expression of the fruit not unlike the wines of Rioja Baja, the only difference is that ours sees no oak. Knock this wine back on its own or enjoy it with meats and vegetables coming off the grill.	2OZ. \$5	GL \$12	46CL \$30
#8	ROGUE RED, COOPERS HALL, ROGUE VALLEY, OR '15 Merlot headlines in this glass of wine, followed by a laundry list of supporting cast members. It's not as much about the grape varietals but what they express about the Rogue Valley in 2015—a rich, ready to drink wine with great balance between fruit and structure.	2OZ. \$4	GL \$10	46CL \$25
#12	MALBEC, COOPERS HALL, GOLD VINEYARD, APPELEGATE VALLEY, OR '15 While still a formidable wine, our winemaker Phil Kramer notes that the 2014 is "more delicate" than prior vintages. I would add that it has an openness and affability out of the gate, while still retaining good structure. All aged in neutral oak, the fruit stands out on its own.	2OZ. \$5	GL \$13	46CL \$33

#9	GAMAY NOIR, SADNESS AND GAMAY, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OR '17 A collaborative project between our sommelier, Joel Gunderson, and Evan Martin of Martin Woods. #14	BETON(CABERNET FRANC ET AL), DIVISION-VILLAGES, OR '17 Headlining with Cabernet Franc, followed by Gamay, Côt, and Pinot Noir, this little gem of a bistro drinker just shows how dedicated the good people at Division are to making badass wines that don't need a ton of age.	2OZ. \$5	GL \$12	46CL \$30
#15	DOLCETTO, HOLDEN, COLUMBIA GORGE, OR '15 All from a single vineyard just outside of Hood River sitting at about 900 feet in elevation, this wine gives us a fresh, happy look at dolcetto. Ripe fruit, to be sure, but slightly tart in its presentation, this wine is super refreshing and thirst quenching.	2OZ. \$4	GL \$10	46CL \$25
#16	MOURVÈDRE, SWICK, COLUMBIA VALLEY, OR '16 Here's a completely different look at this grape variety. It reminds me of how Maxime Mognon approaches Carignan/Cinsault in Corbieres, revealing elegance and restraint to a regions mostly known for ripeness and power.	2OZ. \$5	GL \$12	46CL \$30

#38	CHARDONNAY, COOPERS HALL, CUVÉE ALEXELI, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OR '17 Some of our favorite Chardonnays come out of the Mâconnais in southern Burgundy with their pure, unfettered expression of the grape. They can be straight forward while retaining a sort of simple elegance, a quiet energy that can surprise you.	2OZ. \$4	GL \$10	46CL \$25
#40	GEWURZTRAMINER, COOPERS HALL, ALEXELI, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OR '15 Yes! A dry gewürztraminer with acidity and balanced alcohol. If you think you know this wine then I think reintroductions are in order. Drink this down while the sun still shines.	2OZ. \$4	GL \$9	46CL \$23
#41	(SKIN CONTACT) CHARDONNAY, COOPERS HALL, ALEXELI, WV, OR '14 One of the great things about keg wine is that we get to play with styles a bunch. #19	ROSE OF GSM, MATTHIASSEN, MENDOCINO/NAPA, CA '17 When Steve and Jill Klein Matthiasson decided to put their rosé in a keg, I thought I had just won the lottery. Easily one of the top emerging producers in the New California movement, their wine speaks to something close to the earth. While it carries the refinement and finesse of Napa, there is something more essentially earthbound in their wines.	2OZ. \$5	GL \$12	46CL \$30
#30	RAMATO (PINOT GRIS), GOODFELLOW CELLARS, WV, OR '16 This wine will redefine the way you think about Pinot Gris. Left on the skins for four days, the ramato comes from the final press cycle of the fruit, which gives its great texture and copper hue. This is a truly savory style of white wine, and while you could drink it on its own, I might recommend a little food to accompany it.	2OZ. \$4	GL \$10	46CL \$25
#31	DOLCETTO ROSATO, VIOLA WINE CELLARS, COLUMBIA GORGE, WA '17 When wildfires smoke out your vineyard, rosé is there to save the day. In a shout out to those who are helping with the recovery project of the Gorge, we will donate 10% of sales of this wine to Friends of the Gorge.	2OZ. \$4	GL \$10	46CL \$25
#32	MELON DE BOURGOGNE, HELIOTERRA, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OR '17 Anne Hubach recently poured this wine at a fundraiser for the Wetlands Conservancy, and organization that we are partnered with. We had her stationed right next to the oysters, because really, that's what this wine is all about—minerality and salinity!!	2OZ. \$5	GL \$12	46CL \$30
#33	CHARDONNAY, FLÂNUER, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OR '16 A single barrel that leans towards the richer style of Oregon Chardonnay, Flânuer is showing off the more opulent style that this fruit can produce.	2OZ. \$5	GL \$12	46CL \$30
#34	GEWURZTRAMINER (ORANGE), LOVE AND SQUALOR, OR '17 What Matt Berson is calling his Rosé of Gewürztraminer is a lovely orange wine expression of the grape, which captures both the aromatic complexity one expects but adds a savory quality to the line-up. Miniscule production all from Sunnyside Vineyard.	2OZ. \$4	GL \$10	46CL \$25
